Call to Order: Commissioner Kingston called the meeting to order at 5 pm.

Public Hearing: Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements 5:00 pm.

Commissioner Kingston opened the public hearing at 5:00 pm. Staff presented the draft of the Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements. Commissioner Kingston called for any public comment. Hearing none he closed the public hearing at 5:01 pm.

Commissioner & Staff Reports

Attorney's Report: Nothing to report.

Finance Manager's Report: We are continuing on a positive path. We have closed the Ecology Interagency Agreement (IAA) grant and the Ecology Integrated Planning Grant and all funds have been received.

Facilities Update: Cascade Business Park – North Bonneville, all streetlight bases and poles are installed, we are waiting on the PUD to install the transformer. There was a failed sewer pump in the Tichenor building that has been replaced. The Beacon Rock Golf Course roof repair and painting project is now complete.

Commission Update: Commissioner Broughton reported on the status of the Washington Investment fund, as it related to the Loan payoff discussion later in the agenda. Commissioners Taylor and Kingston had nothing to report.

Manager's Report: The Port continues to have discussions with a long-term tenant regarding the future of the Evergreen building and future development. The transition process of Beacon Rock Golf Course to a new operator is ongoing. Representative Marie Gluzenkamp-Perez was the bell ringer for the Farmers Market. The WRDA bill has passed the House. We are waiting for the Senate version to pass, then to be reconciled. The conveyance of the Army Corps building is still in the bill, but it currently states that we will have to pay a value set by the US Secretary of State. We are asking to have the language changed to reflect no cost. Army Corps has not yet provided us with a lease for the building. We did not receive any public comment, but have had several communications with Mitch Patton regarding Cascades Business Park.

The Commission Acknowledges the security deposit is less than the 1-year statutory deposit. The motion passed unanimously.
