**RESOLUTION 11-2026**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF SKAMANIA  
COUNTY  
AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF RESTRICTED ACCESS SIGNAGE**

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Skamania County owns, operates, and maintains property and facilities used for public, commercial, industrial, and governmental purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, certain areas of Port property are not intended for unrestricted public access because of safety concerns, operational needs, protection of equipment and infrastructure, security considerations, and the efficient administration of Port facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners finds it to be in the best interest of the Port to clearly identify such areas with signage limiting access to authorized persons only; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners desires to authorize the Executive Director, Pat Albaugh, to determine when and where such signage is necessary and to cause such signage to be posted on Port-owned or Port-controlled property; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Skamania County as follows:

**Section 1.** The Executive Director, Pat Albaugh, is hereby authorized to identify areas on Port-owned or Port-controlled property where access should be limited and to post signs stating "Authorized Access Only," "Restricted Area," "No Unauthorized Entry," or similar language deemed appropriate for the area.

**Section 2.** Restricted access signage may be installed where the Executive Director determines that limiting access is necessary for safety, security, operational efficiency, protection of Port property, protection of infrastructure or equipment, or to reduce interference with Port functions.

**Section 3.** The Executive Director is further authorized to determine the wording, location, size, placement, replacement, and removal of such signage as conditions require.

**Section 4.** Areas posted with restricted access signage shall be deemed limited-access areas, and entry shall be limited to Port personnel, tenants, contractors, emergency responders, and other persons specifically authorized by the Port.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
